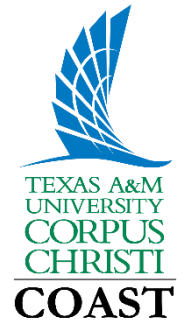

Information on Registration Holds



What are registration holds?

Registration holds are restrictions and notes on your student record which prevent you from making course registration changes at any point in the semester.

Bacterial Meningitis	BMV	Bacterial Meningitis immunization records or exemption waiver must be met and the form on file with the Office of Admissions. Final Transcript Missing Freshmen or Transfer	12 or 13	Students are to submit final official high school and/or college transcripts upon graduation or last term attended at your college or university. Conditional Admit	CN	This hold requires students to meet with their success coach in the Center for Academic Student Achievement (CASA) before registering for courses each semester. Must Confer with Academic Advisor	AC	This hold requires students to meet with their academic advisor before registering for courses each semester. Must Confer with Faculty Mentor	CC	This hold requires students to meet with their faculty mentor before registering for courses each semester.	You will receive email instructions from the department of your major to address this hold.
Owes Balance – Business Office	B2	Failure to pay outstanding charges by deadlines will result in a financial hold on the student’s record. A financial hold prohibits students from future registration, receiving transcripts, or receiving a diploma.	Pay outstanding balance. Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Hold	TSI	This hold is placed on student that do not meet college readiness in one or more of the following: math, reading, writing. Viking – Islander Program (VIP) Admit	VP	This hold requires students to meet with their VIP advisor before registering for courses each semester. Dual Credit Students (Islander Academy / UPHS) -Must Confer with Academic Advisor	AC	This hold will remain in place throughout the entire semester. This hold requires students to meet with their academic advisor before registering for courses, before adding a course and/or before dropping a course.
